The Report:

1st. April 1917 to 1918.

Officers Comd. Jer. Collison, Moneygall, and Wm. Maher, Dublin Road, Nenagh, William Kelly, Borrisfarney, Moneygall units and unit B. Coy, 2 Batt. No. 1. Tipp. Bgde, organising and drilling Coy 2 weekly B. Coy. 2 Batt. Officer Widger Maher the 1st. April '18 to the 31st. March 1919. Denis Kelly, Borrisfarney, Moneygall, William Kelly Borrisfarney, William Maher, Dublin Road, Nenagh B. Coy 2 Batt. No. 1. Tipp. Bgde. February in '18 raid for arms on the house of a J.P. who signed warrants for the arrests of the I.R.A men in the district. Officer Comd. Widger Maher raiding for arms and drilling and trenching roads, training and keeping arms and ammunition. Reference Widger Maher, U.S.A. William Maher Nenagh, William Kelly Borrisfarney from the 1st. April 1919 to the 31st. March 1920 B. Coy 2 Batt No. 1. Tipp. Bgde. Raid for arms and ammunition on the house of a British Officer got rifle and revolvers, 2 shot guns and several thousands rounds of ammunition in A Coy. 2 Batt. No. 1. Tipp. Bgde. officer in charge William Kelly, Borrisfarney prepared and bottled petrol for the attack on Borrisokane Barracks and was in same in June 1920 was in the ambush in Barnane in September 1920 Officer in charge John Burke, Borrisleigh, Tom Ressel, Borrisleigh, D. Coy, 2 Batt, No 1. North Tipp. Bgde. 20th. April 1920 Glanaguile Ambush carried a dispatch under fire to Bgde. Column William Kelly, William Maher D. Coy. 2. Batt Trenched roads between Templemore and Clough Jordan the night of the moderney ambush prepared billets for the A.S.V. and guarded same on different occasion by orders William Kelly Borrisfarney, and Denis Kelly Borrisfarney, D. Coy. 2 Batt. No. 1. North Bgde. April 1st. 1921 to 11th. July in Mid Tipp. Bgde area sniped lorries on the way to Barnane barracks and wounded in same. and on the run until the cease, fire officers in charge Michael Stapleton, and T. Russel, D. Coy 2 Batt. No. 1. North Tipp. Bgde. was in the training camps at Glaniguile and Silver Hills also doing police duty all times. William Maher Nenagh, William Kelly, Borrisfarney, John Egan, Knockanrodger, D. Coy, 2 Batt. North Tipp. Bgde. called to arms the night of the attack in Nenagh, and blocked the main road from Dublin to Nenagh, 2 Batt. No. 1. North Bgde. prepared ambush at Toomevara, Officer in charge P. McDonal. Bgde. D.C. Three attacks on Toomevara Barracks August, October, and November. Officers Denis Kelly Borrisfarney, William Maher, Nenagh, Comd. Joseph Manion in charge, D. Coy. 2 Batt. Sniped out post at Clough Jordan, and cut wires, Denis Kelly in charge.

Coy. 2 Batt North Bgde April 1st 1921 to 11th July in Mid Tipp Bgde area sniped lorries on the way to Barnane Barracks and wounded in same and on the run until the cease fire officers in charge Michael Stapleton and T. Russel, D. Coy. 2 Batt No 1 North Tipp Bgde was in the training camps at Glaniguile and Silver Hills also doing police duty all times. William Maher, Nenagh, William Kelly, Borrisfarney, John Egan Knockanroger, D. Coy. 2 Batt North Tipp Bgde called to arms the night of the attack in Nenagh and blocked the Main Road from Dublin to Nenagh, 2 Batt No 1 North Bgde prepared ambush at Toomevara, officer in charge P. McDonal Bgde O. C. Three attacks on Toomevara Barracks – August, October and November. Officers Denis Kelly Borrisfarney, William Maher, Nenagh, Comd. Joseph Manion in charge D. Coy. 2 Batt sniped out post at Cloughjordan and cut wires, Denis Kelly in charge.
