

ROSCREA, CO. TIPPERARY.

Held on Thursday. Small fair composed of first and second-class store and fat cattle of shorthorn type; brisk demand for all classes, and a clearance almost effected. Springers and milch cows met a quiet trade. Sheep a small supply, and all sold at high prices. Calves under 6 months old, £1 17s 6d to £2 10s, average £2 2s 6d. Store cattle—Over 6 and not exceeding 12 months, 2nd class, £4 5s to £6, average £5; one year old and under two years, 1st class, £10 10s to £12 15s, average £11 10s, live weight average 36s 6d per cwt; 2nd class, £8 15s to £10 5s, average £9 10s, live weight average 35s; two years old and under three years, 1st class, £13 to £14 15s, average £13 10s, live weight average 37s; 2nd class, £11 to £12 10s, average £11 10s, live weight average 36s 6d; three years old and over, 1st class, £15 5s to £17, average £16, live weight average 38s; 2nd class, £13 5s to £14 10s, average £14, live weight average 36s. Fat cattle—Three years old and over, 2nd class, £17 to £20, average £18, live weight average 41s 6d; cows and bulls, 2nd class, £12 to £22, average £16, live weight average 37s 6d. Springers—Cows and heifers, 2nd class, £14 10s to £18, average £16. Milch cows (down calved), 2nd class, £13 to £16 10s, average £14 10s. Store sheep—One year old and under two years, long wools, 40s to 52s 6d, average 45s. Fat sheep—One year old and under two years, long wools, 56s to 70s, average 62s 6d.
