LADIES' GOLF UNION.

London, Monday.

The annual Council meeting of the Ladies' Golf Union was held in the Cafe Monico, London, to-day. Three new clubs, Rothley, Conning, and Rosendale, were elected, making the total of 600 affiliated to the Union. Subscriptions for the year amounted to £786; and the balance at the Union's credit now totals £1,377. All officers were re-elected, and it was resolved that the subscription to the Union during the war be reduced by half.
